This fine Burns Night special opens with Billy Connolly’s classic, D.I.V.O.R.C.E.

Scott’s dressed to the nines in his tartan trousers and red shirt, under a primary coloured tank top. Dennis the Menace and Gloria are tonight’s badges.

This is the first Big Neet In of 2022 and he informs viewers that the show is now into its third year.

The pre-show is brief, with Scott signing out at the four-minute mark, saying: “Av a good un.”

General:

Scott fumbles with his guitar as Amanda puts the puppets to bed.

Amanda is sporting a black Levellers 'Peace' T-shirt, with a flame-like logo on the front and bold white letters on the bottom of the back. She's customised the neck, cutting it wider.

Scott is using his Gibson guitar tonight as his 'workhorse' is packed up ready for an Axis of Mental gig tomorrow.

As tonight's aftershow is taking place on a Friday, rather than its usual Saturday slot, Scott kicks off with the Doonicans' Friday I'm In T'Pub.

120 people had said in a recent poll that they'd watch BNI #75, but Scott says actual numbers were vastly down on that figure. He and Amanda have pondered whether the end of Big Neet In is on the horizon as Covid restrictions are lifted and more and more people are seemingly getting back to normal life. However, a St Patrick's Day show is in the offing, along with a possible show in July, plus Christmas Day and New Years' Eve ones, like last year.

Tommy Fuller from The Horse Puppets is spotted on the chat thread.

Next up is Silk Pyjamas, a song from Billy Connolly's Humblebums' days.

Reading people's comments, Amanda sees that some aren't sure if they'll be available to watch a St Patrick's day show on the Saturday closest to it. Scott: "People av now got to the point where you can go out and do things, and you don't need us anymore, and that's fine...I'm not upset by that. Times av changed."

The final song is Why Does It Always Rain On Me by Travis.

Amanda reminds viewers that there are still some tickets left for Big Neet Out #2 and Scott and Bjorn's show at The Lantern Theatre, in November 2022.

Scott hopes fans will continue to support Big Neet In as he enjoys doing them whenever he isn't out gigging.

He goes and sits next to Amanda.

Bjorn is coming over on Monday to record some more material for the new Doonicans' album Roughe & Lief. Crowdfunding for this has been going well, with Scott reckoning he'll hit his break-even point if around 15 more pledgers get on board.

Despite seeming a bit down at the prospect of the Big Neets In ending, Scott says he's proud of the 75 shows to date.

Scott: "God bless. Goodnight."
